

LIVONIA CHURCHILL EDGE DIVINE CHILD IN QUAD MEET

Divine Child boys went to Cass Benton Park in Northville to compete in a quad meet against division one powers Dearborn High, Dearborn Fordson and Livonia Churchill. The balance squad of Livonia Churchill came out with a narrow victory over Divine Child, 34 – 37. Dearborn High placed third with 61 points while Dearborn Fordson didn't score because they were unable to fill a full team of five.

Dearborn's senior, Charlie Frank, led the entire race to become the individual winner with an outstanding time of 16 minutes 13.8 seconds. Divine Child's sophomore, Michael Hegarty, took second with a 16:56.2. Rounding the top five were Livonia Churchill's, Cameron Kruse (Sr), 3rd – 17:08.6 and Owen Swisher (Jr), 4th – 17:11.8; Placing 5th was Divine Child's Shaun McGrath (Sr) with a 17:27.1.

Dearborn Fordson's top runner was Marwan Algahmi (Jr) who took 6th with a 17:34.2. Livonia Churchill was able to achieve the team victory by placing their first five runners in the top eleven places. Divine Child had only three athletes in the top 10.

The following five places for Divine Child were Ryan Ware (Sr), 8th – 18:05.3; Kyle O'Connor (Sr), 12th – 18:21.2; Dylan McGrath (So), 13th – 18:28.3; Adam Polakowski (Sr), 16th – 18:45.3 and Nader Zahr (Sr), 17th – 18:59.2.

Divine Child will host the **University of Detroit Jesuit** in a dual meet at Nankins Mills in Westland's Hines Park, on Tuesday, October 13th at 4:30PM. On Saturday, October 17th, they will travel to **Kensington Metro Park** in Milford, MI, for the Catholic League Championship at 10:00AM.
